EARLY YEARS AND FOUNDATION STAGE



The Early Learners Curriculum is designed as a strong foundation for preparatory sections, with a particular focus on engaging young learners through the playbased approach as they embark on their learning journey to becoming more proficient in reading, writing, and numbers. The Early Learners environment is thoughtfully designed to be child-friendly, enabling students to independently discover and learn from available resources in a safe and nurturing setting. It offers various areas for exploration, including play spaces, creative zones, and nap/rest areas.

Each day commences with a 30-minute circle time, where children have the freedom to select materials from the shelves at their own pace, all under the attentive supervision of teachers and caregivers. Our Nursery school is organised into three distinct levels:

- Playgroup (Ages 1-2)
- Nursery 1 (Ages 3-4)
- Nursery 2 (Ages 4-5)



THE AREAS OF LEARNING IN NURSERY SCHOOL

COMMUNICATION LANGUAGE AND LITERACY DEVELOPMENT

The objective of this component is to foster the learner's self-assurance in communicating effectively and actively listening to both peers and adults with prolonged concentration. Students are provided with a diverse array of resource materials and books to enable them to develop the capability to read and write simple sentences by the conclusion of the Foundation Stage.

LITERACY DEVELOPMENT

Literacy represents a fundamental component of a child's education, as it underpins their capacity to grasp other subjects. Once students have acquired proficiency in their phonics and sounds, we actively promote engaging in reading and writing activities. Reading serves to broaden their vocabulary and enrich their language skills.

THE AREAS OF LEARNING IN NURSERY SCHOOL

PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT.

At our school, we prioritize the holistic development of our students. In the aspect of personal, social, and emotional development, our focus is on instilling in children an empathetic understanding of the needs and emotions of others. We also aim to foster a keen sense of responsibility and a positive attitude towards their environment.

NUMBER ACTIVITIES, PROBLEM SOLVING AND REASONING.

This area aims at building the learner's confidence in working with numbers and understanding the relationship between numbers. We help children develop their numerical skills like counting, identification, quantifying, matching, sorting, pattern making, and making connections between shapes.

KNOWLEDGE AND UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD (KUW)

KUW is aimed at teaching learners of their environment and things happening around them; this forms the foundation for other subjects that will be taken at the end of the Foundation Stage. The everyday use of computers and tablets in learning helps them to interact and improve on their ICT skills.

CREATIVE DEVELOPMENT

Our creative development program empowers learners to express their thoughts, ideas, feelings, and moods through various artistic outlets, including art and craft, music, dance, role play, and imaginative activities.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

This section takes the children through the positive attitude of staying healthy and active by living healthy with physical activities. This develops their movement skills, manipulative, and coordination skills as well as the importance of space in all movements.

PRIMARY SCHOOL

Our primary school is the perfect place for your child, to embark on an exciting educational journey. Learning here starts from Grade 1 through Grade 6, we believe in providing a well-rounded education that draws from the rich traditions of the Nigerian, British and American educational systems. OUR SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT AND ADD ON SERVICES

Motivating Environment

We use every opportunity to teach! Our environment is structured in such a way that even the walls tell a story. The classes are designed to ensure comfort and productivity.

Encouragement and counselling We recognise that the state of mind of every child is essential to learning. Nothing misses our eye, by observation and counselling we always make sure that our pupils are in a stable and happy frame of mind. When pupils join our school, we make note of their temperament and personality, we are careful not to dampen the day of a sensitive child.

Support and tutoring.

By differentiation, we recognise children require an extra push when others might not. Our tutoring scheme is designed to help the less able, whilst teaching the older child responsibility. This scheme makes learners eager to learn, as they look forward to sharing new knowledge.

Mentorship

Quarterly, the school invites professionals from different sectors to give inspirational talks. We discover early on what piques the interest of our learners and then we steadily groom these interests.

Community Partnerships/ Social Care.

Raising children with a sense of social responsibility is part of the mission of this great school. We need learners who are aware of all aspects of society; it informs who they turn out to be in future. We teach our pupils to count their blessings by fulfilling a need in the community.

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY.

Our learners are guided on how to use digital devices. As pupils move to higher classes, they are instructed on how to constructively access information on the internet, create word documents, fully use the tools like Microsoft Word, and how to collaborate on google workspace and Canva etc. Pupils are also engaged in activities and games that require them to input and analyse simple data.







FIRST AID AND SAFETY PROCEDURE IN SCHOOL

Parental Responsibility: Parents should not bring an unwell child to school. Upon arrival, our teachers are trained to promptly access a child's well-being.
Sick Child Protocol: If school authorities determine that a child is too ill to attend, the child is sent home for two primary reasons: to prevent the spread of infections to other students and to avert potential health emergencies.

•Medical Information Collection: The school collects medical information from parents during the registration process. This information is vital for understanding a child's medical history and any specific health requirements.

• Injury Response: In case of an injury in school, trained personnel provide basic first aid until further medical assistance is obtained.



Response to Illness: If a child feels unwell during the school day, the following steps are taken:

a. Access Medical Records: The child's medical record is retrieved to understand their medical history, conditions, or allergies.

b. Symptom Observation: The child's symptoms are carefully monitored to assess the nature and severity of the illness.

c. Medication Check: School staff check if parents had provided scheduled medication for the child on that day.

d. Parental Contact: If necessary, the school contacts the parents to inform them about their child's condition and to seek guidance.

e. Medication Administration: If advised by the parent or the child's doctor, the school administers medication to the child.

f. Rest in Medical Room: The unwell child is allowed to rest in the school's medical room while further arrangements are made, whether it involves taking the child home or to the hospital.



Uniform Dress Code: Pupils are required to wear formal school uniforms on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday. The school's designated sportswear should be worn on Wednesday, and red or white tops on a bottom of choice on Fridays.

Punctuality: All pupils must arrive at school no later than 8:00 am daily to ensure a timely start to the school day.

Timely Pickup: Parents are responsible for picking up their children at the stipulated time to ensure the safety and well-being of all students.

Respect for School Property: Everyone in the school's premise is expected to respect school property, and any damage to school property will incur a fee to cover repair or replacement costs.





Coloured Hair Extensions: The use of coloured hair extensions is not permitted within the school's dress code policy.

Beads: Beads are not allowed due to safety concerns, as they can pose an accident risk.

Mobile Phones: Mobile phones are not allowed within the school premises, to maintain a focused and distraction-free learning environment.

Uniforms from Previous Schools: Uniforms from previous schools are not welcome, as the school's specific uniform is required.

Chewing Gum: Chewing gum is not permitted within the school, as it can be disruptive and challenging to manage in the educational setting.

It is essential for both parents and pupils to adhere to these school policies to maintain a conducive learning environment and ensure the safety and well-being of all students.
